8 am Holy Communion

There is a Service of Holy Communion every Sunday at 8am at St Vigor's except where there is a 5th Sunday in the month. On the 1st and 2nd Sundays the Service is in modern language (*Common Worship*) and on the 3rd and 4th Sundays the service follows the *Book of Common Prayer* (17th Century).

11 am Services at St Vigor's

St Vigor's has an 11 am service every week, except on the 5th Sunday in the month when the congregations in our four villages meet together to worship. This happens at a different church each time, usually at 11 a.m.
