Children and Youth

We aim to welcome people of all ages. We have a parents' & babies' area at the back of church and on 2nd, 3rd & 4th Sundays we run a Sunday school for those aged 4 and over. There is also a crèche area available for parents & children.. Please ask for more details.

8 am Holy Communion

There is a Service of Holy Communion every Sunday at 8 am at St Vigor's except where there is a 5th Sunday in the month, when the congregation is encouraged to worship with other congregations in the area at our Joint Service . On the 1st and 2nd Sundays the Service is in modern language (*Common Worship*) and on the 3rd and 4th Sundays the service follows the *Book of Common Prayer* (17th Century).

Sunday Afternoons at Home Close

At **Home Close**, (a nursing & residential home on Cow Lane, Fulbourn).

On the 2nd & 4th Sundays we hold afternoon services at 2.45pm and also hold regular services of Holy Communion.
