Let your merciful ears, O Lord, be open to the prayers of your humble servants; and that they may obtain their petitions make them to ask such things as shall please you; through Jesus Christ your Son our Lord, who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever.

In our gospel today, Jesus heals a woman who has been crippled with a painful spinal condition for 18 years. It is the Sabbath, and, then as now, there is a dispute about whether this kind of healing—for the woman's life is not at risk—should be performed on the day of rest. A pivotal moment comes when the narrator identifies Jesus as 'the Lord.' Jesus'



authority is elevated above that of the synagogue leader. He frames this healing as a matter of cosmological significance: on this holy day God is revealed through Jesus as the One who defeats the evil one. Liberation from bondage is a fundamental characteristic of God's realm. This passage challenges all who have settled into narrow interpretations of Scripture or ungenerous theological positions. To be stuck in a rut is not unlike being bent and crippled. Jesus liberates the synagogue leader here to think again about what it might mean to be brought out from slavery and made a new creation.
